

Medical Identity Theft

What is Medical Identity Theft?

Someone uses personal information such as your name, Social Security Number or Medicaid ID number to submit fraudulent medical claims.

How to prevent Medical Identity Theft?

- Never share your personal information and Medicaid number with unknown persons.
- Only give your personal information and Medicaid Member Card to doctors.
- Don't respond to unsolicited requests for your personal information.
- Never share your Medicaid Member Card with anyone else.
- Report a lost Medicaid Member Card to Utah Department of Workforce Services at: 866-435-7414
- Review bills and Medicaid claims to see if something was billed you never received.
- Hang up on anyone that calls and asks for your personal information.
- Report questionable charges and suspected fraudulent Medicaid activity to Utah OIG.
